
Before you begin, take a moment and open all your Front Runner rack kit boxes and gather the assembly instructions for the various components.







# 2 FIT AND SECURE




With the help of a friend, hold your Front
Runner Roof Rack over your vehicle's Flush
Rails. Find the best position to mount.
The Rack should sit level to the ground, not
the vehicle's roof line, or slanting slightly
down toward the front.

Find the best position to mount the Feet to the Rack using the first or second Slat.


Remove the Rack from the vehicle.

Flip the Rack so that the bottom of the Rack faces up. Insert two M8 x 16 Hex Bolts (Item 1) into the Slats machined slots that you have identified.


Fit the Rail Foot Base (Item 2) to the slat by loosely fastening it with two M8 Flat Washers (Item 3) and two M8 Nyloc Nuts (Item 4).

Repeat this step for the other Feet.



Remove the Front Covers (Item 9) from all the Base Feet (Item 2) by loosening the two M5 x 10 Button Head Screws (Item 10).

Loosen and remove (Item 8, 7 & 6) keep in a safe place as this will be used in the next step to fit the grips.



Depending on the width of the Rail, use an M6 x 60 or M6 x 50 Allen Cap Screw (Item 8 or 11), M6 Spring Washers, Washer (Items 7 & 6). Loosely fit the Grip to the Base Foot (Item 2).

Repeat this step on the other Base Feet.




Place your Rack back onto the vehicle.

Position all the feet so that they rest on top of the Flush Rails as shown.



With a measuring tape, center your Roof Rack from left to right.

Fully tighten all the M6 x 50 or M6 x 60 Cap Screws (Item 8) to securethe Rack onto the rails.

### **Tightening Torque 6Nm**

Fully Tighten all the M8 Nyloc Nuts (Item 4) and cover each of them with M8 Nut Caps (Item 5).

Make sure there are no movement on the rack after fully tightening all the fasteners.

Refit the Front Cover Plates (Item 9) with the M5  $\times$  10 Button Heads (Item 10).
